Discussion Questions:

- 3. How do you justify accepting the forgiveness of God while resisting the Lordship of Christ?

- 5. Read Luke 9:24–25 aloud. What key words stand out to you? Would you say your faith is costing you anything presently? If so, what? If not, should it be?
