Discussion Questions

- 1. Would you rather always be 10 minutes late or always be 20 minutes early?
- 2. At the beginning of the message Jame asked, "Would you rather have 1 million dollars or a penny that doubles each day for 30 days?" Which did you pick and why?
- 3. In your own words; How does the concept of compound interest (the penny) apply to our relationships and spiritual life? In what ways have you seen small investments in relationships or faith make a big difference in your life or the lives of others?
- 4. **Read 2 Corinthians 1:1-5.** How can you apply Paul's teaching and this idea of personal ministry to your own life, using your experiences to comfort and encourage others?
- 5. If you haven't already, let's specifically talk difficult situations... Can you think of a personal experience where God leveraged a difficult situation for your own good and/or the good of others?
- 6. Through personal ministry, our faith grows and we see how God uses our strengths, talents, and experiences for His glory and the comfort of others. How has serving and volunteering within the church community impacted your personal faith and relationship with God?
- 7. **ACTION STEP Joining The Mission & Personal Ministry Opportunities:** Jame mentioned examples such as serving in guest services, leading small groups, volunteering in production, or working in family and student ministries. Which of these opportunities appeal to you, and how can you leverage your unique experiences and gifts to serve in these areas?
